PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES








ACCOMMODATION





MEDICAL SERVICES

- Championship regulations require each delegation to insure its members prior to registration;
- Commitment by the Ministry of Health and Social Protection to coordinate the health coverage plan for the event;
- Medical care will be provided to all accredited persons;
- A doctor with medical staff and an ambulance vehicle will be present at each venue during competition and training hours;
- A doctor will be available on call 24/7 at all accommodation;
- An agreement may be signed with a private health establishment;
- Coordination with the institution responsible for the anti-doping programme and even for scheduling anti-doping tests and awareness and/or training sessions.





HEALTH PROTOCOL

Health protocol and response measures against SARS-CoV-2:

- It should be noted that the current global and national epidemiological situation is relatively stable and reassuring, with a decrease in positive cases, severe and critical cases and deaths, as well as a considerable rate of vaccination coverage against Covid19;
- Properly managed and planned mass gatherings can be conducted safely;
- The staff in charge of medical services must ensure the supervision of the implementation of the health protocol measures;
